Subject: Notice of Penalty from the Metropolitan Waterworks and Sewerage System - Regulatory Office ("MWSS RO")

Ladies and Gentlemen:

Maynilad Water Services, Inc. (the "**Company**") received a notice from the MWSS RO imposing a penalty on the Company in connection with water service interruptions that affected the southern portion of its concession area. The interruptions occurred during the recent Amihan season and were caused by weather-driven changes in raw water conditions in Laguna Lake.

These conditions necessitate operational adjustments at the Company's treatment facilities, including reductions in plant production levels to ensure that treated water continued to comply with the Philippine National Standards for Drinking Water, resulting in reduced treatment plant output during the period.

Following its review of the matter, the MWSS RO determined that the interruptions constituted a failure to meet the Service Obligation on water availability under the provisions of the Revised Concession Agreement ("**RCA**").

Under the RCA's regulatory framework, financial penalties may be imposed when defined service obligation thresholds relating to water availability are determined by the MWSS RO to have been exceeded.

Based on the MWSS RO's regulatory computation under the RCA relating to water availability obligations, the total penalty amounts to ₱42,569,790.85, equivalent to ₱432.92 per water service connection.

In accordance with the MWSS RO's directive, the penalty amount will be rebated to affected customers through credits applied to their water bills.


The Company will comply with the MWSS RO's decision.

The Company continues to implement operational improvements and infrastructure upgrades to strengthen the reliability and resilience of water supply in the southern portion of its concession area, particularly during periods when weather conditions affect raw water intake from Laguna Lake.
