- Leading end-to-end card solutions provider and manufacturer AllCard partners with ACEN RES to transition its operations to 100% renewable energy
- Through the partnership, AllCard avoids around 631 metric tons of CO2 emissions annually
- The transaction was enabled through the government's Green Energy Option Program (GEOP)

08 May 2026 — AllCard Inc., the Philippines' leading provider of end-to-end card solutions, has officially partnered with ACEN Renewable Energy Solutions (ACEN RES) to switch its entire operations to 100% renewable energy.

The move was facilitated through the government's Green Energy Option Program (GEOP), allowing AllCard to source all of its electricity from ACEN's diverse portfolio of solar, wind, and geothermal plants. By shifting to renewables, AllCard avoids approximately 631 metric tons of CO2 emissions annually—a significant milestone in the company's push to integrate sustainability goals into its manufacturing core.

Under the Renewable Energy Act of 2008, the GEOP allows qualified end-users with a peak demand of at least 100kW to choose licensed renewable suppliers like ACEN RES. ACEN RES currently leads this segment with a 65% market share, according to the Philippine Electricity Market Corp (PEMC). This partnership underscores ACEN's role as the primary enabler for Philippine businesses aiming for Net Zero carbon emissions.

"At AllCard, we recognize that our growth must be synonymous with sustainability. Shifting to full renewable energy through ACEN RES is a pivotal step in reducing our carbon footprint while ensuring that our production processes remain resilient and future-ready. We are happy to partner with ACEN RES to power our next decade of innovation with clean energy," said Aaron dela Paz, Chief Experience and Operations Officer, AllCard Inc.
