Subject: Notice of Penalty from the Department of Environment and Natural Resources – Pollution Adjudication Board (“DENR-PAB”)

Ladies and Gentlemen:

Maynilad Water Services, Inc. (the “**Company**”) received a copy of the DENR-PAB’s Order dated 5 May 2026 (“**Order**”) this afternoon, 18 May 2026, imposing on the Company a penalty of Thirty-Seven Million, Four Hundred Fifty-Four Thousand Three Hundred Forty Pesos (₱37,454,340.00) for violation of Republic Act No. 9275 or the Philippine Clean Water Act of 2004 and its implementing rules and regulations.

The penalty was imposed in connection with the DENR-PAB's finding that certain effluent samples taken from the Company's Valenzuela Water Reclamation and Recycling Facility ("the **Valenzuela WRF**") exceeded the prescribed limits for the Chloride and Nitrate parameters under DENR Administrative Order No. 2016-08, or the Water Quality Guidelines and General Effluent Standards.

The Valenzuela WRF, located at Bgy. Marulas, Valenzuela City, is designed to treat up to 60,000 cubic meters/day of wastewater generated within select barangays in Valenzuela City, and its treated effluent is discharged to the Tullahan River.

The Company intends to file a motion for reconsideration of the Order within the prescribed reglementary period and, if warranted, to pursue such other legal remedies as may be available under applicable laws and regulations.
