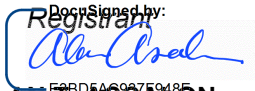

ACS Manufacturing powers production of Filipino household brands with 100% renewable energy from ACEN RES

- Manufacturer of Pride Detergent, Shield Bath Soap, and Unique Toothpaste switches to green energy to align with environmentally conscious shoppers
- Through this partnership, ACS Manufacturing avoids an estimated 4,270 metric tons of CO₂e annually
- The partnership was facilitated through the government's Retail Competition and Open Access (RCOA) and Retail Aggregation Program (RAP)

09 September 2026 — ACS Manufacturing Corporation (ACS), the producer behind household brands such as Pride Detergent, Shield Bath Soap, and Unique Toothpaste, has entered into a retail electricity supply agreement with the Ayala group's retail electricity unit ACEN RES. Under the agreement, ACEN RES will power the company's two key manufacturing facilities in Laguna with 100% renewable energy sourced from ACEN's diverse portfolio of solar, wind, and geothermal power assets.

The partnership was facilitated through the government's Retail Competition and Open Access (RCOA) and Retail Aggregation Program (RAP). RCOA is a mechanism that allows large electricity consumers with a peak monthly demand of at least 100 kilowatts (kW) to choose their own supplier rather than being limited to the local franchise utility. RAP, meanwhile, allows a group of smaller facilities or end-users to combine their power requirements to reach the 100kW minimum demand required to participate in RCOA. These programs empower businesses to negotiate more competitive rates and specific power sources, such as 100% renewable energy.

By making the switch to renewables, ACS Manufacturing avoids the emission of an estimated 4,270 metric tons of carbon dioxide equivalent (tCO₂e) annually. This is equivalent to the estimated amount of carbon dioxide absorbed by more than 193,000 trees annually.

"Our switch to renewable energy for our Laguna plants is a strategic move to align our manufacturing processes with our commitment to the environment," said Mai Supetran, Chief Executive Officer of ACS Manufacturing Corporation. "We see this as a way to enhance our operational efficiency while tangibly reducing our carbon footprint. Partnering with a reliable group like Ayala ensures that as we produce quality products for Filipino homes, we are also contributing to a sustainable future for the communities we serve."

ACEN RES continues to expand its footprint in the retail electricity market, supporting the national goal of increasing the share of renewables in the country's energy mix while empowering businesses and institutions to exercise greater control over their power supply sourcing. The retail supplier has maintained its position as the leading green energy supplier in the country based on the Energy Regulatory Commission's (ERC) latest report on the competitive retail electricity market (CREM).



As an Ayala company, ACEN RES leverages the group's long-standing reputation for reliability and customer service to provide tailored energy solutions to Philippine industries.

In recognition of this commitment, ACEN RES awarded ACS its "Powered by Renewable Energy" badge. This token of recognition honors the company's dedication to environmental sustainability and is a distinction shared by hundreds of ACEN RES-powered facilities across the country.
